

## Enoki Iqittuq's Complaint

~ This summer Enoki & his wife were going home from Ottawa. When they went to the Boarding Home in Iqaluit they were given a room which had a male person already there. They had to move somewhere else so that they could be alone. They went to the Bed & Breakfast instead. This was not a comfortable feeling.

Before they start traveling, they are given a paper that they are asked to sign. Nobody explains what they are signing.

~ On February 17, 2023 Enoki went to Iqaluit and was given a room in the Boarding Home that smelled really bad. He informed the people in the office but he was not moved until he told the staff that he is a former MLA and he told them that he would talk with Minister John Main. He was kicked out of the Boarding Home on February 20, 2023 when he tried to help someone who he thought was being mistreated. He took a picture and he was told that no one should take any pictures of the staff. He was asked to delete the picture and was asked not to go out until he deleted the picture. He was informed that he could not get out of the Boarding Home until he had deleted the picture. He told them that he deleted it so that he could go out. He was also informed that they have the power to search his things. They don't have search warrants. He is 68 years old and was mistreated and the Boarding Home people have to apologize to him.

He is not the only one that the Boarding Home people have to apologize to.

- Enoki's older brother Jack Kamukaka is 72 years old and he was asked by the Boarding Home staff to find his own place to stay at. If this problem is not fixed Enoki will ask the people for help.
